*After a long lay up in Trinidad and an extensive refit "Spirit of Oysterhaven" is nearing completion for a season of Caribbean cruising.*

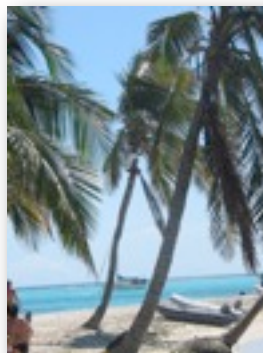
*If you want to learn the ropes, practice helming or navigation or just relax and enjoy sailing in warm trade winds this is cruising in comfort.*
